2010.11 SEASON REVIEW

Cavaliers Key Dates In The 2010-11 Season

October 27 – Cleveland opened the 2010-11 season with a 95-87 home victory over Boston at The Q. The Cavaliers had six players score in double figures, led by J.J. Hickson, who finished with a game-high 21 points on 8-11 (.727) shooting and six rebounds. Daniel Gibson scored 11 of his 16 points in the fourth quarter and finished with a career-high tying eight assists and four rebounds.

November 5 – Defeating Philadelphia 123-118, Anderson Varejao notched his first double-double of the season with 23 points on 10-10 shooting and a team-high 12 rebounds. Varejao became only the third Cavalier ever to have shot 10-10 or better from the field in a game: Johnny Warren (12-12) and Zydrunas Ilgauskas (10-10) most recently versus Washington on Jan. 23, 2008. Mo Williams scored 22 points and added a team-high seven assists in his first start this season.

November 6 – The Cavs defeated the Wizards 107-102 for their first victory in Washington since April 6, 2007. Mo Williams scored 10 of his game-high 28 points in the final four minutes of the fourth quarter. Williams is the first Cavalier to score 10-or-more points in the final four minutes of a win since Jan. 21, 2009 when he did it himself at Portland. His tally came on 10-19 (.526) shooting and he added four rebounds, three assists and two steals.

November 9 – The Cavs defeated New Jersey 93-91 to sweep three consecutive road games on the Atlantic Coast. J.J. Hickson recorded his first double-double of the season with 18 points on 8-14 (.571) and 10 rebounds. Cleveland's bench was led by Ramon Sessions and Antawn Jamison, who each had 15 points and Daniel Gibson, who added 14 points. Jamison added three assists, Sessions added five assists and Daniel Gibson had four assists. It is the first time in over 14 years that the Cavs have had three bench players register double-digits in points and at least three assists in a game. The last time it happened was on Feb. 29, 1996 when reserves Dan Majerle (16 points; three assists), John Crotty (19 points; five assists) and Bob Sura (12 points; five assists) led the team to a win over Milwaukee.

November 19 – After grabbing 11 rebounds and knocking down three three-pointers in 28 minutes off the bench against New Orleans, Antawn Jamison joined Scottie Pippen and Dirk Nowitzki as the only players in NBA history to have 7,000 rebounds, 900 three-pointers made and 17,000 points for their careers. Jamison added a team-high 20 points as the Cavs shot a season-high .941 (32-34) from the free throw line. The last time the Cavs shot .941 or better from the line while attempting 30 or more free throws was December 30, 1993, when the Cavs shot .944 (34-36) against Milwaukee. The Cavs also had a season-high 65 bench points against the Hornets.

November 24 – With the game tied at 81, Mo Williams hit the game-winning shot as time expired to give the Cavs an 83-81 home victory over Milwaukee. Williams scored 21 of his game-high 25 points in the second half (13 in the third quarter), including the Cavs' last eight points in the final 4:24 of the game.

December 8 – Anderson Varejao scored 17 points and grabbed 12 rebounds while recording his fifth double-double on the year and shot 7-7 from the field versus Chicago to become only the third player in franchise history to shoot at least 7-7 from the field two times in one season (Tyrone Hill in 1996-97 and Luke Rackley in 1970-71).

December 17 – In his 500th career game, Mo Williams finished with 22 points and 11 assists at Indiana.

December 18 – Anderson Varejao recorded his seventh double-double of the season with 14 points, a season-high 17 rebounds, two steals and four blocks in a 109-102 overtime win over New York at The Q. Mo Williams notched his second consecutive double-double with a team-high 23 points and a season-high 14 assists. His 14 assists are the most he's had in a Cavaliers uniform.

December 20 – Daniel Gibson connected on a career-high seven three-pointers on eight attempts (.875) and finished with a career-high 29 points versus Utah. Mo Williams recorded his third straight double-double with 16 points and 10 assists and the Cavs made a season-high 12 three-pointers.

December 22 – With his 18 points at Atlanta, Mo Williams surpassed 7,000 points for his career. He also dished out 11 assists for his fourth straight double-double.

December 26 – Anderson Varejao had a team-high 12 rebounds versus Minnesota and with his third offensive rebound, passed Tyrone Hill (955) for eighth place in franchise history in offensive rebounds. Mo Williams notched his career-long fifth straight double-double (17 points, 11 assists), which are the franchise's most consecutive points-assists double-doubles since Andre Miller did it seven times in a row from Feb. 5-21, 2002.

December 29 – Anderson Varejao had a career-high five blocks and Ramon Sessions added a then season-high 22 points at Charlotte.

January 2 – Antawn Jamison notched his third double-double of the season with a season-high 35 points on 14-22 (.636) shooting and a team-high 10 rebounds versus Dallas. Ramon Sessions added 19 points, a season-high seven rebounds and a then season-high 12 assists for his first double-double of the season. Sessions became the first Cavs player in franchise history to tally at least 19 points, seven rebounds and 12 assists off the bench.

January 5 – Antawn Jamison had back-to-back 30-point games for the first time as a Cavalier after scoring 32 points versus Toronto. Ramon Sessions shot a perfect 12-12 from the charity stripe to become the first Cavs bench player to shoot at least 12-12 from the free throw line since Dec. 21, 1997 when Derek Anderson shot a perfect 16-16 from the charity stripe.

January 7 – The Cavaliers had a season-high 15 steals at Golden State. Manny Harris recorded his first career double-double with 16 points and 10 rebounds.

January 14 – Antawn Jamison became the 23rd active NBA player to appear in 900 games at Utah. He finished with a double-double of 26 points, 11 rebounds, two assists and two blocks against the Jazz. Hickson also notched a double-double with 21 points, 14 rebounds, three assists and two blocks. There was only one other such game in franchise history where two Cavs players recorded at least 21 points, 11 rebounds, two assists and two blocks: December 19, 1990 versus the Los Angeles Lakers (Brad Daugherty – 23 points, 15 rebounds, six assists, 2 blocks and Larry Nance – 26 points, 15 rebounds, two assists, three blocks).

Cavaliers Key Dates In The 2010-11 Season

January 22 – In Chicago, J.J. Hickson recorded his fifth double-double of the season with a career-high 20 rebounds (a career-high 11 offensive) and 13 points. His 20 rebounds were the most by a Cav since Drew Gooden grabbed 21 boards against Phoenix in overtime on November 10, 2004. The last Cavs to have 20 or more rebounds in a regulation game was Carlos Boozer who had 20 rebounds at Dallas on March 30, 2004.

January 25 – J.J. Hickson tallied 12 points, 17 rebounds, a career-high five assists and four blocks at Boston, becoming the first Cavs player to produce those numbers in a game since Larry Nance did it on Jan. 19, 1989 (18 points, 18 rebounds, seven assists and four blocks). Three Cavaliers rookies scored at least 10 points against Boston (Eyenga – 15, Harris – 14 and Samuels – 10). The last time the Cavs had three rookies score at least 10 points in a game was December 27, 2002 at Indiana (Smush Parker – 13, Carlos Boozer – 10 and Dajuan Wagner – 10).

February 4 – At Memphis, J.J. Hickson recorded his eighth double-double of the season with a career-high tying 31 points and 15 rebounds in 39 minutes. Ramon Sessions scored 20 points on 8-13 (.615) shooting and added four rebounds and a game-high tying 11 assists in 41 minutes against Memphis to record his third double-double of the season.

February 9 – Ramon Sessions notched his fifth double-double of the season with 20 points on 7-11 (.636) shooting, six rebounds, a game-high 12 assists and a career-high five steals in 43 minutes versus Detroit. It was only the second game in franchise history that a Cavs player recorded at least those numbers (LeBron James had 33 points, nine rebounds, 12 assists and five steals on February 5, 2008 against Boston).

February 11 – After connecting on a field goal at the 9:14 mark of the third quarter, Antawn Jamison became the ninth active player to surpass 18,000 points for his career in a 126-119 overtime win against the Clippers at The Q. Jamison had a strong performance, finishing with a season-high tying 35 points on 11-20 (.550) shooting, including 4-6 (.667) from long range, nine rebounds, four assists and two steals in 44 minutes. J.J. Hickson recorded his 12th double-double of the season (16th of career) with 27 points on 12-19 (.632) shooting and a game-high 14 rebounds, while also adding a career-high tying four blocks in 45 minutes. In his first action since Jan. 15, Mo Williams finished with 17 points and a season-high tying 14 assists for his 10th double-double this season (42nd of career). The last time a Cavs player had 14 assists off the bench was Terrell Brandon, who had 14 assists and 18 points on Dec. 21, 1993 versus Utah. The Cavs also set season-highs in points (126) and assists (34).

February 16 – In a 104-99 win over the Lakers at The Q, Ramon Sessions finished with a season-high 32 points on 9-16 (.563) shooting, eight assists and three steals. He also shot 13-14 (.929) from the free throw line. The last time a Cavs player scored at least 30 points off the bench was Larry Hughes on Dec. 11, 2007 versus Indiana (36). Sessions is the first Cavaliers reserve in franchise history to have at least 32 points, eight assists and three steals in a game. Antawn Jamison notched his ninth double-double of the season with 19 points and 10 rebounds. With his fifth defensive rebound, Jamison became the 13th active player to have 5,000 career defensive rebounds.

February 24 – The Cavaliers acquired a 2011 first round pick and Baron Davis from the Los Angeles Clippers in exchange for Mo Williams and Jamarco Moon. In a separate trade, the Cavs acquired Semih Erden and Luke Harangody from the Boston Celtics in exchange for a second round pick in the 2013 NBA Draft. The team also waived forward Leon Powe.

February 25 – The Cavaliers won their 10th straight game over New York, as well as their eighth consecutive victory over the Knicks at The Q with a 115-109 win. The Cavs had a season-high 10 blocks. The team set season highs in offensive rebounds (19) and total rebounds (62), while also tying their season-high in defensive rebounds (43).

February 27 – J.J. Hickson had his second straight game with at least 20 points and 15 rebounds after tallying a game-high 22 points and 16 rebounds (16th double-double of the season) versus Philadelphia. The last Cavalier to have consecutive games of at least 20 points and 15 rebounds was Zydrunas Ilgauskas, who did it from Feb. 25-27, 2005.

March 2 – In his first career start, Samardo Samuels recorded his first career double-double with a career-high 23 points on 10-18 (.556) shooting and a career-high 10 rebounds (a career-high eight offensive rebounds) in 34 minutes. He also added a career-high three assists. The last Cavs' player to post a double-double in his first NBA start was Carlos Boozer (16 points and 11 rebounds) on Nov. 22, 2002.

March 4 – In his Cavaliers debut, Baron Davis scored 18 points, including shooting 4-7 (.571) from three-point range, to go along with three rebounds and five assists to lead the Cavs to their third victory over New York this season, 119-115. The Cavs bench shot 9-16 (.563) from three-point range. The nine makes off the bench is the most three-pointers made by the Cavs bench since they made nine against Philadelphia on January 26, 2007.

March 29 – The Cavs shot a season-high 35-63 (.556) from the field, including 9-17 (.529) from beyond the arc, in their 102-90 win over Miami. The Heat's 30 rebounds ties the Cavs' opponent season-low for rebounds in a game.

April 5 - J.J. Hickson notched his 23rd double-double of the season with 16 points and a game-high 19 rebounds (a career-high 16 defensive rebounds) in a 99-89 victory over Charlotte. With 13 rebounds in the first half, Hickson tied The Q's record for rebounds in a half. The Cavs outscored the Bobcats 34-16 in the first quarter.

April 6 – Against Toronto, Baron Davis dished out eight assists in the first quarter, which is the most assists in a quarter since April 9, 2010, when Delonte West had eight assists in the second quarter against Indiana. Davis finished the night with his seventh double-double of the season with 19 points and 12 assists (the most he's had as a Cavalier).

2010-11 Cavaliers Season Game Notes

GETTING DEFENSIVE: For the month of March (15 games), the Cavs gave up just 99.8 points per game compared to giving up 109.4 points per game in February (11 games). Their 9.6 point per game improvement from February to March was the biggest jump in the league.

GOOD NUMBERS, GOOD COMPANY: J.J. Hickson put up great numbers from the start of 2011 to the end of the season and it has put him in good company. From Jan. 1 until end of season (49 games), Hickson averaged 16.1 points and 11.0 rebounds per game, making him one of only six people in the league to average at least 15 points and 10 rebounds per game in 2011. The other players on the list are Dwight Howard, Blake Griffin, Zach Randolph, Al Jefferson and Kevin Love.

NO DRAFT? NO PROBLEM: Cavs undrafted rookies Manny Harris and Samardo Samuels spent the season climbing the annals of most points scored by an undrafted rookie for the Cavaliers. Harris finished the season in second in team history with 321 points this season and Samuels finished at fourth with 288 points this season. Smush Parker leads the list with 408 points in the 2002-03 season.

SCHOOL IS IN SESSIONS: This season, Ramon Sessions proved he is one of the best backup point guards in the NBA and his numbers back it up. In 43 games off the bench, **Sessions averaged 4.5 assists per game which was the best in the NBA.** Sessions' 12.2 points per game off the bench was the 8th best in the league among backups. He also had a 2.80:1 assist to turnover ratio when he comes off the bench which was the sixth best in the league among all backup players. (minimum 40 games)

HAPPY NEW YEAR: Antawn Jamison turned his game up since the new year. The box at right illustrates his jump in 2011 across the board especially at home before his injury. High games from the new year include a 35-point, 10-rebound performance against Dallas on January 2 and another 35-point game against the Clippers on February 11th in which he also added nine rebounds, four assists and two steals, while shooting 4-6 from three-point range.

A FEBRUARY TO REMEMBER: The Cavs put up some great offensive numbers for the month of February and beat some quality teams in the process, including the Los Angeles Lakers and the New York Knicks. For the month, (11 games), the Cavs averaged 106.1 points which ranked fourth in the league in February and 24.4 assists per game which was the third best in the league for the month.

BENCH MARK: Against the Nets on Nov. 9, the Cavaliers bench was led by Ramon Sessions and Antawn Jamison, who each had 15 points and Daniel Gibson, who added 14 points. Jamison added three assists, Sessions tallied five assists and Daniel Gibson had four assists. It is the **first time in over 14 years that the Cavs have had three bench players register double-digits in points and at least three assists in a game.** The last time happened was on Feb. 29, 1996 when reserves Dan Majerle (16 points; three assists), John Crotty (19 points; five assists) and Bob Sura (12 points; five assists) led the team to a win over Milwaukee. The following night against the Nets, Jamison and Sessions had 14 points with Ryan Hollins adding 11 points. **The last time the Cavs had three reserves or more score at least 10 points in consecutive games was Nov. 25-26, 2008 against New York (Anderson Varejao – 11, Wally Szczerbiak – 15, J.J. Hickson – 10, Daniel Gibson – 10) and Oklahoma City (Wally Szczerbiak – 13, Tarence Kinsey – 11, J.J. Hickson – 14, Daniel Gibson – 15).** (Elias)

RARE AIR: With his 20 points and 11 rebounds against New Orleans on November 19, **Antawn Jamison joined Scottie Pippen and Dirk Nowitzki as the only players in NBA history with at least 7,000 rebounds, 900 three-pointers made and 17,000 total points.** Jamison currently has 18,128 career points, 7,332 rebounds and 980 three-pointers made.

FREE AND EASY: The Cavs shot a **season-high .941 (32-34) from the free throw line** against New Orleans on November 19. **The last time the Cavs .941 or better from the line while attempting 30 or more free throws was December 30, 1993,** when the Cavs shot .944 (34-36) against the Milwaukee Bucks.

ANDY'S ENERGY: Anderson Varejao notched a **double-double with 17 points on a perfect 7-7 shooting, a team-high 12 rebounds, two steals and one block in 37 minutes against Chicago on December 8.** This was the second time of the season Varejao made at least seven field goals without missing a shot (10-10 at Philadelphia on Nov. 5). He became the third player in franchise history to shoot at least 7-7 from the field two times in one season (Tyrone Hill in 1996 and Luke Rackley in 1970). Varejao recorded his first double-double of the season against the Philadelphia 76ers on Nov. 5, when he led the Cavaliers with 23 points on 10-10 shooting and a team-high 12 rebounds. This was **Varejao's second career 20-10 game, with the first one being 22 points and 10 rebounds in a win over Portland on Dec. 11, 2009.** Only **two other Cavs have ever shot 10-10 or better from the field in a game:** Johnny Warren (12-12) and Zydrunas Ilgauskas (10-10) most recently versus Washington on Jan. 23, 2008.

SELLOUT STREAK: From the last 29 games from the 2008-09 season to January 21st, 2011 (including seven 2009 playoff games and six in 2010), **The Cavs sold out 102 consecutive games at The Q.** This season, the Cavs sold out 25 of their 41 home games.
